Mentoring


From the start of the graduate program graduates will be matched with a mentor to help provide guidance and support along the way.

A mentor will not take on a management position, however the mentor will be there to support you along your journey.





The program journey







Learning and development

The program is based on 70/20/10 principle with the support of a dedicated mentor, whereby 70% of the learning is from organic, but structured on the job learning and development, 20% is from self-development and the remaining 10% is from formal training courses.



On the job training - 70%

Construction (eight months)

Working within our operations team you will be exposed to all aspects of active projects and project management tasks.

Design (eight months)

Our design and estimating teams will take you through our tendering process for all types of heavy foundation and ground engineering project submissions.

Workshop (one month)

Our workshop facilities maintain our fleet of plant and ancillary equipment, whilst also designing and developing tooling to suit. You will be exposed to the role our workshops play in contributing to the operational advantages on our projects.

Human resources (one month)

Working with our human resources team you will be exposed to the recruitment and onboarding process, HR legislation, employee relations, employee engagement and diversity, equity and inclusion.

Commercial /legal (one month)

Our local commercial lead will develop your knowledge of the vital role that commercial awareness contributes to our operational effectiveness.

HSEQ (one month)

The HSE team will take you through incident investigation, documenting controls, consultation, monitoring and compliance. You will develop an understanding of legislation, risk management, hazard identification and control processes.

Finance (one month)

Developing knowledge around our accounts payable/receivable process, procurement, workplace and project reporting, our finance team will demonstrate how it interacts with the business.

Placement (one month)

You will have the opportunity to work either with an interstate team, on a major project or within one of our Keller-owned companies.



Self development 20%

Throughout the program, there will be an element of selfdevelopment in which graduates will be required to take ownership of additional learning through a variety of platforms.

Structured training 10%

Alongside Keller on the job training, graduates will be enrolled onto the Engineers Australia's Graduate Program. This program is delivered online over 18 months through a mix of flexible live and self-paced learning.

What's included?

- Membership with Engineers Australia
- 18 month graduate course program
- Dedicated workshops

Key modules include:

- Personal empowerment communication, self-management, emotional intelligence and resilience
- Project management project management life cycle, problem solving, stakeholder engagement and risk management
- Professional skills leadership, innovation, teamwork and critical thinking





Intake dates

The first intake will start with Keller in mid 2023 and candidates will be enrolled on the March Engineers Australia intake. The graduate program will run each year.
